

Platelet-rich plasma Therapy (PRP)



What is PRP?

Platelets are the cells in the blood that help tissue to heal and grow new cells. The PRP, injected into specific areas of the skin, act as a matrix that promotes your own collagen to grow, regenerates tissue, and naturally smooth and tighten the skin.

How is it done?

A small amount of your blood is drawn and is then placed in a centrifuge and spun to separate the platelets and plasma from the other components of the blood. The platelets contain several growth factors that can help stimulate cell growth, collagen and tissue regeneration. After the plasma and platelets are separated from the rest of the blood, they are injected into areas where you want to have more youthful skin.



How is PRP used?

PRP can treat anything from fine lines and sun damage to deep wrinkles and acne scarring. PRP is used as a topical treatment in conjunction with Microneedling, IPL, or Fraxel Dual skin resurfacing. PRP is also injected into the scalp to stimulate hair growth. It can also be used with different fillers for a greater and longer result.

Procedure time:

Platelet-Rich Plasma Therapy takes about 30-45 minutes depending on which areas are treated. We generally apply numbing cream prior to minimize any discomfort.
